  - The daily sacrifices ceased when Antiochus Epiphanes desecrated the temple. (167 AD)
  - ♦ Romans (Titus) breached city walls. A Roman official (Apustumus) burned a Torah scroll, and an idol was erected in the temple. (70 AD)

## 5<sup>th</sup> month (Summer)

- ➤ Jerusalem carried away captive in this month. (Jeremiah 1:3)
- > Jeremiah confronts and rebukes false prophet Hananiah who then dies in 2 months. (Jer. 28:1)
- ➤ 1<sup>st</sup> Aaron died on Mt. Hor 40 years out from Egypt. (Num. 33:38)
- > 1<sup>st</sup> Ezra arrived at Jerusalem. (Ezra 7:9)
- ➤ 4<sup>th</sup> Ezra weighed the silver and gold and offered sacrifices after arriving safely in Jerusalem. (Ezra 8:31-36; 7:9)
- ➤ 4<sup>th</sup> Nehemiah started building Jerusalem's wall. (Neh. 6:15)
- > 7<sup>th</sup> Nebuchadnezzar captured Jerusalem and took captives. (2 Kings 25:8)

- $ightharpoonup 9^{th}$  a long list of bad things happened to Israel on this "fast of the fifth month." (Zech. 8:19)
  - Sin of the spies caused the Lord to decree no entry into the Promised Land. (Num. 13-14)
  - Destruction of 1<sup>st</sup> temple in Jerusalem. (586 BC)
  - Destruction of 2<sup>nd</sup> temple in Jerusalem. (70 AD)
  - Romans conquered Betar the last Jewish fortress during Bar Kokhba revolt. (134 AD)

  - Expulsion of Jews from King Ferdinand in Spain. (1492 AD)
  - World War I began leading to the holocaust. (1914 AD)

- ➤ 10<sup>th</sup> This fast will turn to joyful gladness one day. (Zech. 8:19)
- > 15<sup>th</sup> Solomon dedicated the temple (2 Chron. 5:3-7:23 and 1 Kings 8)

- ≥ 20<sup>th</sup> Ezra addresses improper marriages. (Ezra 10:9)
- > 24<sup>th</sup> "Consider this day" mentioned 3x. Foundation of the Lord's temple is laid. (Hag. 2:10-23)
- > 25<sup>th</sup> First day of the week long Feast of Dedication. (John 10:22)

## 10<sup>th</sup> month (Winter)

- ➤ In the 10<sup>th</sup> month Esther was taken to the king in his 7<sup>th</sup> year to become queen. (Esther 2:16-18)

- ➤ 10<sup>th</sup> History says this day there was a fast that will turn to joyful gladness one day. (Zec. 8:19)
- ➤ 12<sup>th</sup> Ezekiel's word against Pharoah that Egypt will be desolate. (Ezek. 29:1)

# 11<sup>th</sup> month (Winter)

- ➤ 1<sup>st</sup> Moses spoke and reviewed God's word to His people. (Deut. 1:3)
