EXACT DATES AND HOLIDAYS GIVEN IN SCRIPTURE

1st month ABIB (Spring)

- – The beginning of months. (Exodus 12:2)
- – Israel came to the Wilderness of Zin. Miriam died and was buried here. (Num. 20:1)
- – The former and latter rains will come in the first month. (Joel 2:23)
- 1st – Noah removed ark covering and ground was dry. (Gen. 8:13)
- 1st – Set up Tabernacle and a cloud filled it! (Ex. 40:2,17)
- 1st – Hezekiah starts cleansing and sanctifying and repairing the temple. (2 Chron. 29:3,17)
- 1st – Cleanse the sanctuary for the beginning of the use of the millennial temple. (Ezek. 45:18)
- 1st – Judgment on Tyre & Egypt through Babylonian army. (Ezek. 29:17, 26:1)
- 1st – Ezra leaves Babylon and starts travel and journey to Jerusalem. (Ezra 7:9)
- 1st – Ezra finishes questioning marriages with Pagans. (Ezra 10:17)
- 1st – Nehemiah starts his travel and journey to start building Jerusalem's wall. (Neh. 2:1)
- 4th – Daniel began his 21 day fast. (Dan. 10:4)
- 7th – Cleanse the sanctuary for everyone who has sinned. (Ezek. 45:20)
- 8th – Priestly ministry begins, glory of LORD appears! (Lev. 9:1,6,23,24)
- 8th – Hezekiah arrives at the porch of Yahweh in the temple. (2 Chron. 29:17)
- 9th – Ezra calls a 3 day fast to pray for travel safety to Jerusalem. (Ezra 8:15,21,31)
- 9th – Jesus anointed by Mary in Bethany for his upcoming crucifixion. (John 12:1)
- 10th – Passover lamb taken into the house. (Ex 12:3)
- 10th – Israel comes up from the Jordan river 40 years after being in the dessert. (Josh. 4:19)
- 10th – Ezekiel's visions of the Millennial temple. (Ezek. 40:1)
- 10th – Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. (Matt 21:1-17)
- 11th – Jesus speaks to fig tree and cleanses the temple. (Mark 11:11-19)
- 12th – Ezra leaves Babylon to go to Jerusalem from the river Ahava. (Ezra 8:31,15)
- 12th – Jesus' authority questioned by scribes and teaches many parables in the city. (Mark 11,12)
- 13th – Evil king makes decree to kill Jews. (Esther 3:12)
- 13th – Jesus anointed in Bethany again, Jesus was betrayed by Judas. (Mat 26:1-16, Mk 14:1-11)
- 14th – **Feast of Passover** given to Moses. (Ex. 12,23 & Lev. 23)
- 14th – Moses keeps the Passover 1 year after the Exodus. (Numbers 9:1-14)
- 14th – Joshua keeps the Passover in Gilgal 40 years after Exodus (Joshua 5:9-6:27)
- 14th – Josiah restores the Passover. (2Chron. 35, 2 Kings 23:22)
- 14th – A future Millennial temple will keep the Passover as shown to Ezekiel. (Ezek. 45:21-23)
- 14th – Ezra & Nehemiah keep Passover. (Ezra 6:19)
- 14th – Jesus was Crucified on Feast of Passover. (John 19:31)
- 15th-21st – **Feast of Unleavened Bread** given to Moses. (Lev. 23)
- 15th – Israelites departed from Egypt with their riches. (Num. 33:3, Ex. 12:36)
- 15th-21st – Ezra & Nehemiah keep Unleavened Bread. (Ezra 6:22)
- 15th – Joshua ate the food of the Promised Land. (Josh. 5:11)
- 15th-16th – Jesus was Buried on the Feast of Unleavened Bread. (Luke 23:52-24:3)
- 16th – Manna ceases the day after they ate the produce of the Promised Land. (Joshua 5:12)
- 16th – Hezekiah finishes sanctifying the temple. (2 Chron. 29:17)
- 16th – Jesus Rose from the dead on the First Sunday after Passover. (John 20:1)
- 17th – Moses and children of Israel cross the Red Sea. (Exodus 3:18, 5:3 & chapter 14)
- 17th – Esther intercedes to save the Hebrews from elimination. (Esther 3:12, 5:1)
- 21st – Joshua defeats Jericho after 7 days of marching around it (Joshua 6)
- 24th – Daniel's vision of Jesus and the future. (Daniel 10:4)
- 26th - **Feast of Firstfruits**. Second Sunday after Passover - (Lev. 23)

2nd month (Spring)

- – Solomon began to build the house of the Lord. (1 Kings 6)
- – Ezra began to build the second house of the Lord. (Ezra 3:8)
- 1st – Moses took a census 2nd year out of Egypt. (Numbers 1:1,18)
- 2nd – Solomon began to build the house of the Lord. (2 Chron. 3:2)
- 10th – God tells Noah, “In 7 days the floods will begin.” (Gen. 7:4,10)
- 14th – **Second Passover for those who were unclean. (Num. 9:11)**
- 14th – Hezekiah restores 2nd month Passover for those unclean. (2 Chron. 30)
- 15th – Israel came to the Wilderness of Sin and murmured against Moses. (Exod. 16:1)
- 16th – Israel received the manna “bread from heaven” and quail. (Ex 16:6-8)
- 17th – The rains of the flood began and they entered the ark. (Gen. 7:11)
- 20th – Israel left Wilderness of Sinai for first travel in the 2nd year out of Egypt. (Num. 10:11)
- 23rd – Israel arrives in Taberah after a 3 day journey and fire of Yah fell! (Num. 10:12, 33; 11:3)
- 27th – Earth was dry and Noah left the ark in 2nd year after flood. (Gen. 8:14)

3rd month (Spring)

- – Asa king of Judah assembled in Jerusalem to enter a covenant with Yahweh and seek Him in the 3rd month. (2 Chron. 15:10)
- – Hezekiah laid up heaps of tithes/offerings from this 3rd month, through the 7th. (2 Chron. 31:7)
- 1st – Ezekiel’s word against Pharaoh king of Egypt and all his multitude. (Ezek. 31:1)
- 15th – **Feast of Pentecost. 50 days after Feast of Firstfruits (Ex. 23 & Lev. 23)**
- 23rd – Mordecai & scribes write to free the Jews at a later date. (Esther 8:9)
- 27th – Forty days of rain finally ended on this last day of rain in Noah’s flood. (Gen. 7:11,12)

4th month (Summer)

- 5th – Heaven opened for Ezekiel to see God and cherubim. (Ezek. 1:1)
- 9th – Surrounded Jerusalem runs out of food and was penetrated by Babylon and Judah flees. (2 Kings 25:3, Jer. 39:2, 52:6)
- 12th – Ezekiel made a watchman and the glory appears to make him mute. (Ezek. 1:1, 3:15, 23)
- 17th – long list of bad things happened to Jerusalem on this fast of the fourth month. (Zech. 8:19)
 - ◆ Moses smashed the 10 commandment tablets after seeing the sin of the golden calf.
 - ◆ City wall breached by Babylonians resulted in the daily sacrifices being halted. (586 BC)
 - ◆ The daily sacrifices ceased when Antiochus Epiphanes desecrated the temple. (167 AD)
 - ◆ Romans (Titus) breached city walls. A Roman official (Apustumus) burned a Torah scroll, and an idol was erected in the temple. (70 AD)

5th month (Summer)

- – Jerusalem carried away captive in this month. (Jeremiah 1:3)
- – Jeremiah confronts and rebukes false prophet Hananiah who then dies in 2 months. (Jer. 28:1)
- 1st – Aaron died on Mt. Hor 40 years out from Egypt. (Num. 33:38)
- 1st – Ezra arrived at Jerusalem. (Ezra 7:9)
- 4th – Ezra weighed the silver and gold and offered sacrifices after arriving safely in Jerusalem. (Ezra 8:31-36; 7:9)
- 4th – Nehemiah started building Jerusalem’s wall. (Neh. 6:15)
- 7th – Nebuchadnezzar captured Jerusalem and took captives. (2 Kings 25:8)

- 9th – a long list of bad things happened to Israel on this “fast of the fifth month.” (Zech. 8:19)
 - ◆ Sin of the spies caused the Lord to decree no entry into the Promised Land. (Num. 13-14)
 - ◆ Destruction of 1st temple in Jerusalem. (586 BC)
 - ◆ Destruction of 2nd temple in Jerusalem. (70 AD)
 - ◆ Romans conquered Betar the last Jewish fortress during Bar Kokhba revolt. (134 AD)
 - ◆ The temple area was plowed exactly one year later on this date as well. (135 AD)
 - ◆ Expulsion of Jews from King Ferdinand in Spain. (1492 AD)
 - ◆ World War I began leading to the holocaust. (1914 AD)
- 10th – Captured Jerusalem burned. (Jer. 52:12)
- 10th – Elders inquire of Ezekiel who prophesies judgment by fire. (Ezek. 20:1-49)

6th month (Summer)

- 1st – Haggai’s word to Joshua & Zerubbabel to build the Lord’s house. (Hag. 1:1)
- 1st – Teshuvah begins – 40 days of fasting and prayer preparing for Day of Atonement.
- 5th – Visions of temple abominations & glory departs. (Ezek. 8:1)
- 24th – Zerubbabel & Joshua start building God’s house. (Hag. 1:15)
- 25th – Nehemiah’s wall finished in 52 days. (Neh. 6:15)

7th month (Autumn)

- – Hezekiah finished laying up heaps of treasure from the 2nd month Passover. (2 Chron. 31:7)
- – Hananiah the false prophet died according to Jeremiah’s prophecy. (Jer. 28:17)
- – In the 7th month, Ishmael killed Jews and those who feared fled to Egypt. (2 Kings 25:25)
- 1st – **Feast of Trumpets.** (Lev. 23)
- 1st – Ezra the priest read the law. (Neh. 8:2)
- 1st – Began the offerings before the foundation of the temple was laid. (Ezra 3:6)
- 2nd – Ezra read the law to teach people how to observe Tabernacles (Neh. 8:2, 13-18)
- 10th – **Day of Atonement.** (Lev. 16, 23, 25)
- 10th – This fast will turn to joyful gladness one day. (Zech. 8:19)
- 15th – Solomon dedicated the temple (2 Chron. 5:3-7:23 and 1 Kings 8)
- 15th – 22nd – **Feast of Tabernacles.** (Ex. 23 & Lev. 23)
- 15th – 22nd – Solomon kept the Feast of Tabernacles (2 Chron. 8:12-13)
- 15th – 22nd – Jeshua and Zerubbabel kept the Feast of Tabernacles. (Ezra 3:4)
- 16th – Ezra restarted the Feast of Tabernacles and reading the law. (Neh. 8:13, Ezra 3:4,6)
- 17th – Noah’s ark rests on Mt. Ararat after flood waters prevailed for 5 months. (Gen. 8:4)
- 21st – Haggai’s prophecy of the coming glory of God’s house. (Hag. 2:1)
- 22nd – Rejoicing in the Torah Day: went home from the Feast rejoicing! (Neh. 8:18, 1Kings 8:66)
- 22nd – Final day of the Feast where Jesus stood and declared He was living water. (John 7:37)
- 23rd – Solomon finishes dedicating the temple and God appears to him. (2 Chron. 7:10)
- 24th – Israel repents and confesses sins. (Neh. 9:1-3)

8th month (Autumn)

- – Solomon’s house of the Lord was finished (1 Kings 6:38)
- – Zechariah’s word saying, “return to Me.” (Zech 1:1)
- 15th – Jeroboam ordained false sacrifices, but Josiah was prophesied. (1 Kings 12:32,33)

9th month (Autumn)

- – Jeremiah proclaimed a fast because he was going to read God’s word to the king. (Jer. 36:9)
- – Nehemiah first heard about the broken walls of Jerusalem and fasted and wept. (Neh. 1:1)
- 4th – Zechariah’s word “obedience better than fasting,” and visions of the future. (Zech. 7 & 8)
- 17th – Ezra announces to meet in Jerusalem about improper marriages in 3 days. (Ez. 10:8,9)
- 20th – Ezra addresses improper marriages. (Ezra 10:9)
- 24th – “Consider this day” mentioned 3x. Foundation of the Lord’s temple is laid. (Hag. 2:10-23)
- 25th – First day of the week long Feast of Dedication. (John 10:22)

10th month (Winter)

- – In the 10th month Esther was taken to the king in his 7th year to become queen. (Esther 2:16-18)
- 1st – Tops of mountains were seen as flood waters decreased. (Gen. 8:5)
- 1st – Ezra examined the improper marriages. (Ezra 10:16)
- 5th – (evening) Ezekiel’s mouth was opened after 3 years & was no longer mute. (Ezek. 33:22)
- 5th – (morning) Ezekiel was told, “the city Jerusalem has been captured.” (Ezek. 33:21)
- 10th – Nebuchadnezzar starts siege and surrounds Jerusalem. (2 Kings 25:1, Jer. 39:1, Jer. 52:4)
- 10th – Ezekiel’s parable to rebellious Israel about wife dying but cannot mourn. (Ezek. 24:1-2)
- 10th – History says this day there was a fast that will turn to joyful gladness one day. (Zec. 8:19)
- 12th – Ezekiel’s word against Pharaoh that Egypt will be desolate. (Ezek. 29:1)

11th month (Winter)

- 1st – Moses spoke and reviewed God’s word to His people. (Deut. 1:3)
- 10th – Noah opened the ark window and sent out a raven and a dove. (Gen. 8:6-9)
- 17th – Noah sent out dove again which returned with an olive branch. (Gen. 8:10)
- 24th – Noah sent out dove again which did not return. (Gen. 8:12)
- 24th – Zechariah’s visions of future. (Zech. 1:7 through the end of chapter 6)

12th month (Winter)

- 1st – Ezekiel’s word against Pharaoh. (Ezek. 32:1)
- 3rd – Rebuilt temple was finished. (Ezra 6:15)
- 13th-15th – Esther’s victory or Purim. (Esth. 8:12, 9:17-26)
- 15th – Ezekiel’s word to Pharaoh. (Ezek. 32:17)
- 25th – King of Babylon sets free the king of Judah. (Jer. 52:31)
- 27th – King of Babylon sets free the king of Judah. (2 Kings 25:27)
